<i>Progressive document- the more they can do the greater understanding they demonstrate</i>	Christians believe God came to Earth in human form as Jesus.	Christians believe that Jesus is God and that he was born as a baby in Bethlehem.
	Christians believe Jesus came to show that all people are precious and special to God.	The Bible points out that his birth showed that he was extraordinary (for example, he is worshipped as a king, in Matthew) and that he came to bring good news (for example, to the poor, in Luke).
		Christians celebrate Jesus' birth, and Advent for Christians is a time for getting ready for Jesus' coming.

<b>GOSPEL</b>	At the end of each age phase the children should be able to:	
	EYFS	End of Key stage 1
<b>Progressive document- the more they can do the greater understanding they demonstrate</b>	Christians believe Jesus brings good news for all people.	Christians believe Jesus challenges everyone about how to live — he sets the example for loving God and your neighbour, putting others first.
	For Christians, this good news includes being loved by God, and being forgiven for bad things.	Christians believe Jesus challenges people who pretend to be good (hypocrisy) and shows love and forgiveness to unlikely people.
	Christians believe Jesus is a friend to the poor and friendless.	Christians believe Jesus' life shows what it means to love God (his Father) and love your neighbour.
	Christians believe Jesus' teachings make people think hard about how to live and show them the right way.	Christians try to be like Jesus — they want to know him better and better.
		Christians try to put his teaching and example into practice in lots of ways, from church worship to social justice.
