Sports Day Timetable

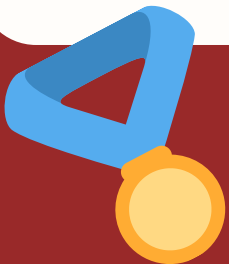
Friday 10th July
